Faithful Navigator's Comments—Robert T. Reynolds

Brother Sir Knights,

Vivat Jesus!

Last month in this message I felt sure that by now we would be in the home stretch of our self-imposed solitude and anticipated a return to normalcy. Now, our solitude has become less voluntary, and a new term has been added to our vocabulary, Social Distancing. I'm sure you're all aware that the light at the end of the tunnel has grown somewhat smaller as the end has been extended, perhaps as late as June. In addition to the obvious impacts on our individual lives, we will have to rethink the ways we conduct Assembly business until our circumstances change.

The Knights of Columbus have launched a new program in response to the limitations imposed by social distancing called "Leave No Neighbor Behind". It is being implemented primarily at the Council level, but many aspects of the program apply to the Assembly. Some of our Sir Knights, may find themselves cut off and isolated, especially those without family in the area or connections to community support systems. If you know or learn of a Brother who is alone please help me to identify him. Call Brothers who are isolated in assisted living facilities. And help shop for those unable to leave their house when you do your own shopping. These same concerns and actions should apply to all of our neighbors, but especially to our Brothers. Also, now more than ever, many in our local community are unable to provide adequate food for their families. Knights can donate to, and assist with, distribution at local food pantries and food banks so no one in their community goes to bed hungry at night.

Now for some Assembly news.

- Two weeks ago, the State held its Biennial Meeting, but with a change in location from Palmyra, VA to our homes. The meeting was held online using a video application called WebEx. Myself and our other two delegates, SKs Fred Beata and Ed Stance, along with our Comptroller SK Kevin Palgutt, "attended" from the Assembly Hall, maintaining a sociable distance. SKs from 77 locations joined the meeting, both audio and 2-way video. Despite the sometimes-amusing issues with the new medium (we watched one unwitting SK puttering in his garage during the meeting) the Master was able to conduct the full meeting agenda, including the passage of resolutions to be forwarded to our Province. I will disseminate the minutes of the meeting and the resolutions in a special email.

- The 4th Degree Exemplification originally scheduled for 18 April has been cancelled.

- Sadly, I regret to inform those who are not aware that our Brother SK Stephen (Steve) J Niezgoda Sr passed away on March 28th. Steve was a member of St Louis Parish and served as an officer in several capacities. Funeral arrangements will necessarily be private. Please pray for the repose of his soul, and for the Niezgoda Family during this time of mourning and great sorrow.

- And finally, this piece of good news: I am unaware of any of our Sir Knights who have been identified as having been infected by COVID-19. Let's all pray that we and our families remain healthy.

We have been encouraged by Supreme to conduct the business of the Assembly virtually so that the very necessary events related to Election of Officers and other business be accomplished on schedule. Accordingly, we will have our 27 April meeting as scheduled in a virtual format. We'll decide on the conferencing tool and get the word out weeks before the meeting, and the Assembly Officers will practice some in advance in order to ensure that we can make this a productive meeting. More to follow.

Finally, if any of you find yourself in need of help, remember that charity, unity, fraternity and patriotism bind us all together. Reach out to a Brother SK. My number is below.




