Dear Brothers,

Lent has just begun. Have you failed yet? As I write this, it is not quite Lent yet. However, I can all but guarantee I will fail in keeping my resolutions during the next forty days. Of course, I won't fail on purpose. I never do. Nor have I ever kept all my resolutions perfectly. That, in part, is the point.

I'm so weak and pathetic that I can't give up coffee or bacon without interiorly whining or exteriorly cutting corners. At the heart of Lent is our preparation for the central mystery of our Faith; the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Lent should be a preparation to help remind us that we need a savior. We cannot save ourselves. Half the time we can't even help ourselves. Fitting for my namesake, I propose a mini-Lenten reflection upon the figure of David. Recall his confidence when he went up to the giant Goliath. Recall how everyone around him wanted him to rely on the conventual strength of armor and swords.

Recall how David knew that his strength came from "The Lord who has delivered me from the paw of the lion and bear" (1 Sam 17:37). The boy David alone against Goliath would have ended in total failure. The boy David with God against Goliath ends in victory. Father David alone against anything ends in failure. Father David with God is unconquerable. Anytime I am pathetic and weak it is because I am trying to do something alone, on my own strength. When I remember that I desperately need God to save me, to strengthen me, to deliver me- then I can experience victory. Whatever our resolutions for Lent, even in our failures, may we learn to become dependent upon God for everything so as to experience greater confidence in His strength.








Viewing and Funeral for Marianne Coates
