Faithful Participation in Commonwealth of Virginia Elections

Last week, St. Louis Church commemorated the feast day of its patron saint, St. Louis IX who lived from 1214-1270. He was a man devoted to His Catholic faith whose mother Queen Blanche would have rather seen him die than to commit a mortal sin. He promoted justice within the realm of France and was always solicitous of the poor. He fought in Crusades to preserve the rights of Christians to make pilgrimages to the Holy Land then occupied by the Saracens.

This coming November are elections for the House of Delegates, the State Senate, Commonwealth Attorney and for Fairfax County Supervisors and School Board Members. This is not the time to sit on the sidelines. The moral issues of our day such as the protection of unborn children, the rights of parents to educate their children as they see fit, and the proper administration of justice are crucial to promoting a moral and just society. Local elections tend not to get much attention since Federal Elections tend to take up most of the air time in the media and the space on social media venues.

Catholic Patriots should be engaged in conversations with all in our local community about these issues and mobilize those who would support the dignity of the human person from conception to natural death, and to vote in this important election. Those who are enemies of the Church who promote abortion and the so called 'transgender movement' are corrupting our society. Those who promote these evils have found their way into elected offices that often no one thinks much about. It is important for all Catholics to faithfully participate in local elections.

I would exhort our Sir Knights and all Knights of Columbus to participate vigorously in this election coming up in November to help elect those who would promote the right to life, parental rights, and the rule of law. This will help build our Commonwealth to be a place where our children can live in true freedom rooted in the promises of our Savior, Jesus Christ.
